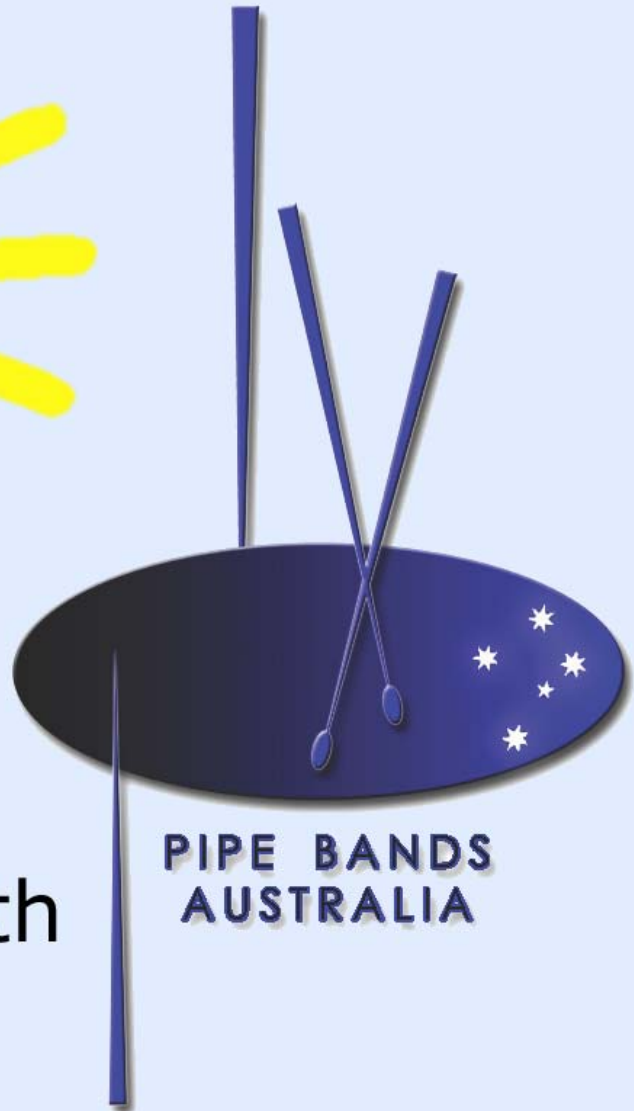

# PROSPECTUS

The APBA Summer School is derived from the objectives stated in the APBA Strategic Business Plan 2009/10 for a national training activity. The 2012 event will be held from Monday 16 January to Friday 20 January 2012, and will be located in Melbourne.

## TUTORS

APBA Summer School will be led by top class overseas and Australian tutors. Jack Lee (Piping) and Reid Maxwell (Drumming) from Simon Fraser University Pipe Band will be the Senior Tutors. Callum MacSween, V/P Qld Branch, will be keynote tutor for mid-section drumming.

## DURATION

The APBA Summer School is a 5 day course for both residential and 'day' participants. Registration and grouping will begin at 3:00pm on Sunday 15 January. The course will conclude at 3:00pm on Friday 20 January.

## LOCATION

Classes will be conducted at the facilities of the Ivanhoe Diamond Valley Centre, 88 McNamara Street, Macleod, VIC 3085.

Residential accommodation will be available at nearby Latrobe University. It is not a requirement to use this accommodation. Participants may choose to arrange their own accommodation.

## HOUSE RULES

The arranged class and residential accommodation facilities are **Drug and Alcohol Free**. In addition, some **curfews and other conditions** apply at the residential accommodation.

**All adults and younger participants must comply.**

## PREREQUISITE

Pipers must be capable of playing a march, such as in the massed band scores, on pipes, and drummers on drum.

## PROGRAMME

### Sunday, 15 January from 3:00pm

- Registration and Grouping.

### Monday, 16 January

- Group lessons throughout the day. Evening private lessons.

### Tuesday, 17 January

- Group lessons throughout the day, plus massed band. Evening private lessons.

### Wednesday, 18 January

- Group lessons throughout the day, plus massed band. Evening private lessons.

### Thursday, 19 January

- Group lessons throughout the day, plus massed band. Evening recital (open to public).

### Friday, 20 January

- Group lessons, student group performances, and conclusion.

## FEES

### Summer School Tuition Fee

- **Standard** (extended until 30 Nov) \$375.00 per person, or \$350.00 for current APBA members, payable with enrolment.
- **Penalty** (after 30 Nov, if spaces available) \$425.00 per person, or \$400 for current APBA members, payable with enrolment.

### Accommodation & Meals

- \$390.00 per person, for Mon—Fri
- Payable with enrolment
- The University has now made Sunday night meal and accommodation available for an additional cost of \$65.00

Individual refunds will only be made in exceptional circumstances.

## ENROLMENT

Applications must be received prior to 30 November 2011 to provide sufficient time to deal with all of the necessary management arrangements. Applications after this date will be considered only if the maximum of 100 has not been exceeded.

Please ensure that your application for enrolment form is fully completed and, most importantly, includes your date of birth. If you do not have an email address, all correspondence to you will be sent after the bulk emails.

## SUPERVISION

Younger participants of APBA Summer School who are resident, will be supervised by qualified adult staff, however children under 13 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian. (Guardian may be a band member approved by parent.)
